Ultra Grass



With added oil

• Oil 3% • Protein 13.5% • Fibre 22%
Workload: Low—Heavy

- Soft, free flowing premium grass.
- Dried at high temperatures to enhance digestibility and palatability.
- Higher in feed value than hay and similar to that of alfalfa.
- Ideal for horses in all levels of work, breeding stock or those requiring extra condition such as veterans or convalescents.

Fibre Plus Nuggets



• Oil 2.5% • Protein 7% • Fibre 21%
Workload: Low—Medium

- Low energy, high digestible fibre nugget.
- Low in starch and sugar.
- Can be used as a partial hay replacer.
- No added vitamins and minerals.
- Ideal for all horses and ponies at rest or in light work.

CHAFFS are short chopped hay and straw products which can play an important role in increasing the fibre content of all diets. Molassed and dust-free, they can be fed on their own or mixed into the hard feeds to bulk out the ration.
